

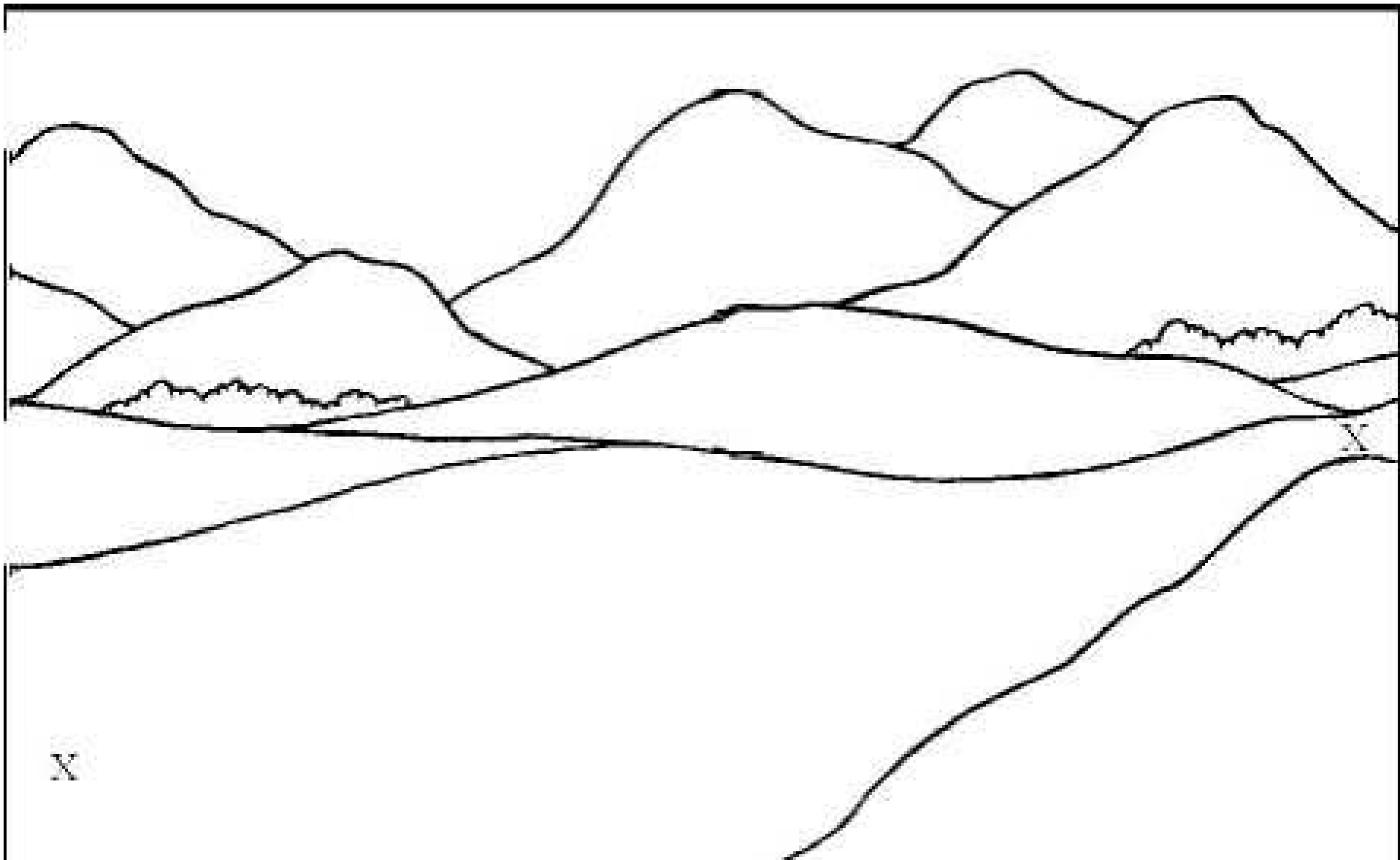

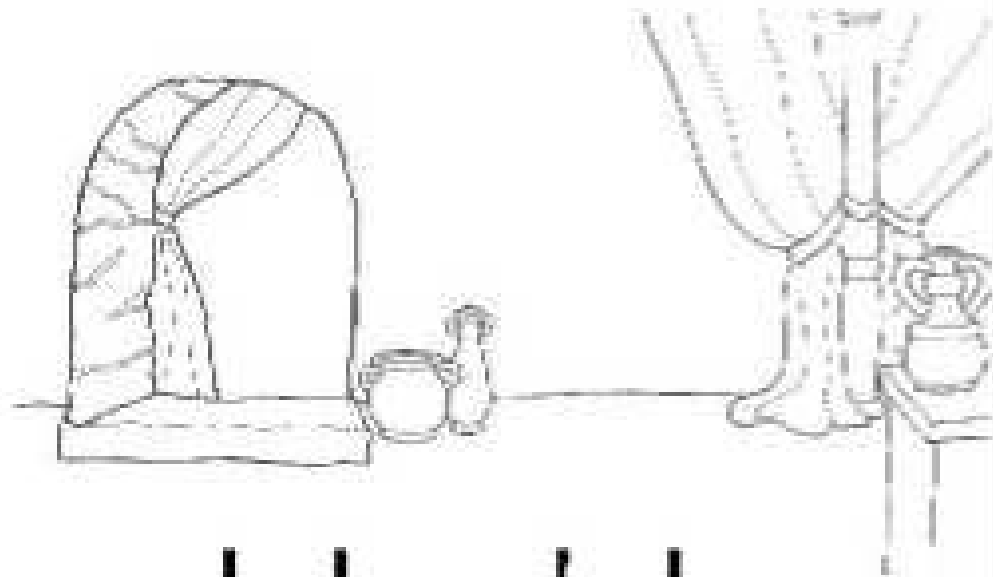
Lesson	Tactile Time	Take-home
<p>Lesson: Luke 1:39-56</p> <p>Focus: Gabriel tells Mary of Elizabeth's baby to come</p>	<p>Toy cars and toy donkeys (compare how we travel to day with how Mary probably traveled, walking or donkey)</p>	<p>Mary Travels to See Elizabeth (pg 2-3)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cut out Mary on donkey (pg 4) • Cut a small slit at each "X" on pg 3 • Thread a 21-inch piece of string/yarn through the page with both ends coming from the back. • Tape Mary to the string at the right side of the page so that when string is pulled from the left she travels across the page.
